LM = Limited Mediation = Amount in controversy up to \$50,000.00, court pays mediator for first 3 hours; parties pay reduced hourly rate thereafter.

CM = CADRe Mediation = Amount in controversy exceeds \$50,000.00, parties pay mediator's market hourly rate.

+ = The mediation ended in non-agreement, but the case settled within 60 days of the non-agreement mediation. As this is another measure of mediator effectiveness, CADRe counts this category of cases toward a Total Resolution rate for each panelist, but not as actual agreements at the mediation session, thus the separate percentages shown for each panelist's agreement rate and for each panelist's Total Resolution rate.

DNA = Does Not Apply = the mediator is not a member of this subpanel.

*** = The mediator is no longer on the Limited Mediation Panel, but remains a member of the CADRe Mediation panel.**

Unknown = Mediator has report(s) outstanding, unable to update records.

****NOTE: From the Judicial Council's Civil & Small Claims Advisory Committee Commentary, SPR05-08: "Although settlement rate is an important indicator of a neutral's effectiveness, it should be borne in mind that some disputes will not resolve, despite the best efforts of a skilled neutral. Neutrals should not feel pressure to achieve a high settlement rate through resolutions that may not be in the interest of one or more parties. Accordingly, settlement rate should be used with caution as a criterion for court referral of disputes to neutrals."**
